## 74LV08-Q100

Quad 2-input AND gate Rev. 2 — 13 September 2021

### 1. General description

The 74LV08-Q100 is a quad 2-input AND gate. Inputs include clamp diodes. This enables the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess  $V_{CC}$ .

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.

### 2. Features and benefits

- Automotive product qualification in accordance with AEC-Q100 (Grade 1)

   Specified from -40 °C to +85 °C and from -40 °C to +125 °C
- Wide supply voltage range from 1.0 to 5.5 V
- CMOS low power dissipation
- Latch-up performance exceeds 100 mA per JESD 78 Class II Level B
- Optimized for low voltage applications: 1.0 V to 3.6 V
- Accepts TTL input levels between V<sub>CC</sub> = 2.7 V and V<sub>CC</sub> = 3.6 V
- Typical output ground bounce < 0.8 V at V<sub>CC</sub> = 3.3 V and T<sub>amb</sub> = 25  $^\circ\text{C}$
- Typical HIGH-level output voltage (V<sub>OH</sub>) undershoot: > 2 V at V<sub>CC</sub> = 3.3 V and T<sub>amb</sub> = 25  $^{\circ}$ C







V<sub>OL</sub> and V<sub>OH</sub> are typical voltage output levels that occur with the output load.



#### Fig. 7. Test circuit for measuring switching times






Fig. 9. Package outline SOT402-1 (TSSOP14)
